Dear Mr. Yenchsky:

On June 14, 2002, the Wisconsin Department of Commerce (Commerce) PECFA Site Review Section received a request for case closure, dated June 11, 2002, from Midwest Engineering Services, Inc. It is understood that residual soil contamination remains on-site. Using the standards established in the NR 700 series, Wisconsin Administrative Code (Wis. Adm. Code), Commerce has determined that this site does not pose a significant threat to the environment and human health. No further investigation or remedial action is necessary.

During the final groundwater sampling event conducted on March 5, 2001, the preventive action limit (PAL) for chrysene was exceeded at monitoring well MW-1, at 0.10 parts per billion. Commerce is issuing a PAL exemption, per NR 140.28(2), Wis. Adm. Code, for chrysene at the referenced property.

The following condition must be satisfied to obtain final closure:

- A notification must be placed on the property deed for 1700 Chicago Street, addressing residual soil impacts. For case closure Commerce will need a copy of the deed notification that contains the County Register of Deeds' recording information. Enclosed is an example of "Notice of Contamination to Property" for your use. If you wish to modify the language, submit a copy of this to the office for approval prior to filing.

As of August 31, 2001, State Statute 101.143 requires PECFA claimants seeking reimbursement of interest costs to submit a final reimbursement claim within 120 days after they receive written notification that no further action is required with respect to the discharge at their site. This letter serves as your written notice of "no further action". If your claim is not received within 120 days of the date of this letter, interest costs incurred after 60 days of the date of this letter will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement. Costs associated with recording deed notices or other restrictions are not eligible for PECFA reimbursement, and the recording of these notices should not delay the claim submittal process.



Please note that although the deed mentioned above contains descriptions to eighteen different parcels owned by the Unified School District of De Pere, only the first of the eighteen parcels needs to be listed in Document 1005321, having Tax Parcel number ED-1128-30, listed in the GIS Registry.

The west line of the subject property is approximately 750 feet west of the centerline of Lone Oak Road; the property then extends approximately 1940' easterly from this west line; the property is bounded on the south by Merrill Street and on the north by Chicago Street.

The subject property is not part of a Certified Survey or a recorded plat.


FIGURE 1: SITE LOCATION


