Dear Ms. Schmelzer:

On February 28, 2011, the Department of Natural Resources Regional Closure Committee reviewed the above referenced case for closure. The Regional Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. On March 1, 2011, you were notified that the Closure Committee had granted conditional closure to this case.

On March 21, 2011, the Department received information or documentation indicating that you have complied with the requirements for final closure. The monitoring wells were properly abandoned and the drums of soil cuttings were properly disposed of.

Based on the correspondence and data provided, it appears that your case meets the closure requirements in ch. NR 726, Wisconsin Administrative Code. The Department considers this case closed and no further investigation or remediation is required at this time, however, you and future property owners must comply with certain continuing obligations as explained in this letter.

GIS Registry

This site will be listed on the Remediation and Redevelopment Program's GIS Registry. The specific reasons are summarized below:

- Residual soil contamination exists that must be properly managed should it be excavated or removed

Closure Conditions

Please be aware that pursuant to s. 292.12 Wisconsin Statutes, compliance with the requirements of this letter is a responsibility to which you and any subsequent property owners must adhere. You must pass on the information about these continuing obligations to the next property owner or owners. If these requirements are not followed or if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, welfare, or the environment, the Department may take enforcement action under s. 292.11 Wisconsin Statutes to ensure compliance with the specified requirements, limitations or other conditions related to the property or this case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code.

Residual Soil Contamination

Residual soil contamination remains at GP-2 (PCE 72.4 ppb and DRO 3,450 ppm) as indicated on the attached map (Figure 3 – Extent of Soil Contamination) and in the information submitted to the Department of Natural Resources. If soil in the specific location described above is excavated in the future, then pursuant to ch. NR 718 or, if applicable, ch. 289, Stats., and chs. 500 to 536, the property owner at the time of excavation must sample and analyze the excavated soil to determine if residual contamination remains. If sampling confirms that contamination is present the property owner at the time of excavation will need to determine whether the material is considered solid or hazardous waste and ensure that any storage, treatment or disposal is in compliance with applicable standards and rules. In addition, all current and future owners and occupants of the property need to be aware that excavation of the contaminated soil may pose an inhalation or other direct contact hazard and as a result special precautions may need to be taken to prevent a direct contact health threat to humans.

On February 28, 2011, the Regional Closure Committee reviewed your request for closure of the case described above. The Regional Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. After careful review of the closure request, the Regional Closure Committee has determined that the VOC contamination on the site appears to have been investigated and remediated to the extent practicable under site conditions. Your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code and will be closed if the following conditions are satisfied:

The monitoring wells MW-1 and MW-2 at the site must be properly abandoned in compliance with ch. NR 141, Wis. Adm. Code. Documentation of well abandonment must be submitted to Jason Moeller on Form 3300-005 found at <http://dnr.wi.gov/org/water/dwg/gw/>.

Any remaining purge water, waste and/or soil piles generated as part of site investigation or remediation activities must be removed from the site and disposed of or treated in accordance with Department of Natural Resources' rules.

When the above conditions have been satisfied, please submit the appropriate documentation (for example, well abandonment forms, disposal receipts, copies of correspondence, etc.) to verify that applicable conditions have been met, and your case will be closed. Your site will be listed on the DNR Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites. 


