



On March 4, 2004, the Northern Region Closure Committee reviewed the above referenced case for closure. This committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. On March 15, 2004, you were notified that the Closure Committee had granted conditional closure to this case:

Based on the correspondence and data provided on July 26, 2006, it appears that your case meets the requirements of ch. NR 726, Wisconsin Administrative Code. The Department considers this case closed and no further investigation or remediation is required at this time.

Please be aware that pursuant to s. 292.12 Wisconsin Statutes, compliance with the requirements of this letter is a responsibility to which you and any subsequent property owners must adhere. If these requirements are not followed or if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, welfare, or the environment, the Department may take enforcement action under s. 292.11 Wisconsin Statutes to ensure compliance with the specified requirements, limitations or other conditions related to the property or this case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code. It is the Department's intent to conduct inspections in the future to ensure that the conditions included in this letter including compliance with referenced maintenance plans are met.


The most recent soil samples that were collected on this property, which were collected on August 26, 2003, contained Benzo(a)pyrene in concentrations that exceeded NR 720.11, Table 2, Wis. Adm. Code, soil standards. The area exceeding soil standards is adjacent to Tank 23 and is identified on the map in Exhibit A: Site Layout Enbridge Pipelines (Lakehead), L.L.C. dated September 26, 2004 and on Figure 1: Approximate Horizontal Extent of Residual Soil Exceeding Generic RCLs dated July 26, 2006. Copies of both maps are attached. Therefore, pursuant to s. 292.12(2)(c), Wis. Stats., the property described above may not be used or developed for a residential, commercial, agricultural or other non-industrial use, unless (at the

time that the non-industrial use is proposed) an investigation is conducted, to determine the degree and extent of Benzo(a)pyrene contamination that remains on the property, and remedial action is taken as necessary to meet all applicable non-industrial soil cleanup standards. If soil in the specific locations described above is excavated in the future, the property owner at the time of excavation must sample and analyze the excavated soil to determine if residual contamination remains. If sampling confirms that contamination is present the property owner at the time of excavation will need to determine whether the material would be considered solid or hazardous waste and ensure that any storage, treatment or disposal is in compliance with applicable statutes and rules. In addition, all current and future owners and occupants of the property need to be aware that excavation of the contaminated soil may pose an inhalation or other direct contact hazard and as a result special precautions may need to be taken during excavation activities to prevent a health threat to humans.

Your site will be listed on the DNR Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites. Information that was submitted with your closure request application will be included on the GIS Registry. To review the sites on the GIS Registry web page, visit <http://dnr.wi.gov/org/aw/r/gis/index.htm>. If your property is listed on the GIS Registry because of remaining contamination and you intend to construct or reconstruct a well, you will need prior Department approval in accordance with s. NR 812.09(4)(w), Wis. Adm. Code. To obtain approval, Form 3300-254 needs to be completed and submitted to the DNR Drinking and Groundwater program's regional water supply specialist. This form can be obtained on-line <http://www.dnr.state.wi.us/org/water/dwg/3300254.pdf> or at the web address listed above for the GIS Registry.





On March 4, 2004, your request for closure of the case described above was reviewed by the Northern Region Closure Committee. The Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. After careful review of the closure request, the Closure Committee has determined that the crude oil contamination on the site appears to have been investigated and remediated to the extent practicable under site conditions. Your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code and will be closed if the following conditions are satisfied:

To close this site, the Department requires that a deed restriction be signed and recorded to address the issue of the remaining soil contamination associated with the site. The purpose of the restriction is to maintain the current industrial use zoning classification for the property.

You will need to submit a draft deed restriction to me before the document is signed and recorded. You may find a model deed restriction enclosed for your use or visit our web site at www.dnr.state.wi.us/org/rr. To assist us in our review of the deed restriction, you should submit a copy of the property deed to me along with the draft document. After the Department of Natural Resources has reviewed the draft document for completeness, you should sign it if you own the property, or have the appropriate property owner sign it, and have it recorded by the Douglas County Register of Deeds. Then you must submit a copy of the recorded document, with the recording information stamped on it, to me. Please be aware that if a deed restriction is recorded for the wrong property because of an inaccurate legal description that you have provided, you will be responsible for recording corrected documents at the Register of Deeds Office to correct the problem.

When the above conditions have been satisfied, please submit a letter to let me know that applicable conditions have been met, and your case will be closed.

If this is a PECFA site, section 101.143, Wis. Stats., requires that PECFA claimants seeking reimbursement of interest costs, for sites with petroleum contamination, submit a final reimbursement claim within 120 days after they receive a closure letter on their site. For claims not received by the PECFA Program within 120 days of the date of this letter, interest costs after 60 days of the date of this letter will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement.

Please be aware that the case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or to the environment.

GIS Registration is not required for this site. Therefore, the Department is returning Enbridge Energy's check # 1111080148. It is attached.








Approximate Lateral Extent of Benzo(a)pyrene In Exceedance of the Non-Industrial RCL of 8.8 ug/Kg




