On March 6, 2003, your site as described above was reviewed for closure by the Northern Region Closure Committee. This committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. On March 25, 2003, you were notified that the Closure Committee had granted conditional closure to this case.

On June 11, 2003, the Department received correspondence indicating that you have complied with the conditions of closure, specifically, documentation of the abandonment of the monitoring wells on site. Based on the correspondence and data provided, it appears that your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code. The Department considers this case closed and no further investigation, remediation or other action is required at this time.

Your site will be listed on the DNR Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites. Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

On March 6, 2003, your request for closure of the case described above was reviewed by the Northern Region Closure Committee. The Closure Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. After careful review of the closure request, the Closure Committee has determined that the petroleum contamination on the site appears to have been investigated and remediated to the extent practicable under site conditions. Your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code and will be closed if the following conditions are satisfied:

The monitoring wells at the site must be properly abandoned in compliance with ch. NR 141, Wis. Adm. Code. Documentation of well abandonment must be submitted to me at the above address on Form 3300-5B found at www.dnr.state.wi.us/org/water/dgw/gw/ or provided by the Department of Natural Resources.

Based on the information submitted, there appears to be residual soil and groundwater contamination in the County Highway A right-of-way. Section NR 726.05(2)(b)4, Wis. Adm. Code, requires you to provide written notification of the presence of residual soil and/or groundwater contamination to the clerk of the town and county or municipality where the right-of-way is located and to the municipal department or state agency that maintains the right-of-way. Please provide me with a copy of the written notification.

Due to the presence of residual soil and groundwater contamination at the site in excess of ch. NR 720 Residual Contaminant Levels (RCLs) and ch. NR 141 Enforcement Standards (ES), your site will be listed on the DNR Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites. Information that was submitted with your closure request application will be included on the registry. To review the sites on the GIS Registry web page, visit <http://gomapout.dnr.state.wi.us/org/at/ct/geo/gwur/index.htm>.

As part of the GIS Registry listing, you will need to submit an updated site map or maps. The map(s) must depict the extent of residual soil and groundwater contamination, including the contamination that has migrated to the County Highway A right-of-way, and also consistently



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depicts the location of replacement monitoring wells PZ-13 and MW-14. This map (or maps) should be forwarded to me at the above address. When the map(s) is received and reviewed, the Department will send you notice of final closure.

You should note also that, according to the Drinking Water and Groundwater program representative on the Northern Region Closure Committee, the site's unused private well likely needs to be abandoned. This abandonment could be either temporary or permanent. Questions regarding well abandonment requirements should be directed to Drinking Water and Groundwater Specialist Nadene Cable at 715-635-4054.

If this is a PECFA site, section 101.143, Wis. Stats., requires that PECFA claimants seeking reimbursement of interest costs, for sites with petroleum contamination, submit a final reimbursement claim within 120 days after they receive a closure letter on their site. For claims not received by the PECFA Program within 120 days of the date of this letter, interest costs after 60 days of the date of this letter will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement.

Please be aware that the case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or to the environment.






Water Level Data 11-27-00

County Right Of Way








 SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP, WISCONSIN






Residual Soil Contamination












Northern Environmental Technologies, Inc. (Northern Environmental) has completed remedial activities at the Former Zimmerman's Four Corners Store, Intersection of County Highway A and County Highway B, Town of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin (Site). The Site has been granted closure by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR). In situations where residual petroleum contamination may remain within a road ROW, the WDNR requires that the appropriate party be notified of the possible residual contamination. This letter serves as written notification of possible residual petroleum contamination of ground water within the County Highway A ROW. Ground-water samples collected from one soil boring (SB-4) and one monitoring well (MW-14) within the County Highway A ROW contained petroleum compound concentrations greater than WDNR enforcement standards. Depth to ground water at the monitoring wells is approximately two feet below grade. Maps of the Site with the location of the residual soil and ground-water contamination in the ROW is included. Northern Environmental Technologies, Inc. (Northern Environmental) has completed remedial activities at the Former Zimmerman's Four Corners Store. The site has been granted closure by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) contingent upon notifying the county and township if soil and/or groundwater contamination remains within the right-of-way. The following information along with the attached maps of the site and locations of remaining contamination should provide you all the necessary information. Please reply to this notification to acknowledge that you received it so the DNR can finalize closure of the site. As we discussed, County Highway A is scheduled for reconstruction in 2005. It appears that no contamination or possibly very little contamination is present directly under the road bed. Petroleum-contamination was encountered within the right-of-way of County Highway A in April 1998 at approximately 2 to 4 fbg. It has not been determined if that contamination has naturally attenuated or if it still remains. I trust this information meets your needs.
