

On October 23, 2007, the South Central Region Closure Committee reviewed the above referenced case for closure. This committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. On October 24, 2007, you were notified that the Closure Committee had granted conditional closure to this case.

On January 5, 2010 the Department received information or documentation indicating that you have complied with the requirements for final closure. Based on the correspondence and data provided, it appears that your case meets the closure requirements in ch. NR 726, Wisconsin Administrative Code. The Department considers this case closed and no further investigation or remediation is required at this time.

GIS Registry

- Groundwater contamination is present above Chapter NR 140 enforcement standards





On October 23, 2007, the South Central Region Closure Committee reviewed your request for closure of the case described above. The Committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state rules and statutes to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases. After careful review of the closure request, the Committee has determined that the chlorinated contamination on the site appears to have been investigated and remediated to the extent practicable under site conditions. Your case has been remediated to Department standards in accordance with s. NR 726.05, Wis. Adm. Code and will be closed if the following conditions are satisfied:

MONITORING WELL ABANDONMENT

The monitoring well at the site must be properly abandoned in compliance with ch. NR 141, Wis. Adm. Code. Documentation of well abandonment must be submitted to me on Form 3300-5B found at www.dnr.state.wi.us/org/water/dwg/gw/ or provided by the Department of Natural Resources.

When the above conditions have been satisfied, please submit the appropriate documentation (for example, well abandonment forms, disposal receipts, copies of correspondence, etc.) to verify that applicable conditions have been met, and your case will be closed. Your site will be listed on the DNR Remediation and Redevelopment GIS Registry of Closed Remediation Sites. Information that was submitted with your closure request application will be included on the GIS Registry. To review the site on the GIS Registry web page, visit <http://maps.dnr.state.wi.us/brrts>.

Please be aware that the case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm.
