Dear Ms. Anderson:

The Wisconsin Department of Commerce (Commerce) has received all items required for closure of the site referenced above. Commerce received a copy of the information for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Geographic Information System Registry of Closed Remediation Sites and monitoring well abandonment documentation. This site is now listed as "closed" on the Commerce database and will be included on the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Geographic Information System (GIS) Registry of Closed Remediation Sites to address residual contamination.

It is in your best interest to keep all documentation related to the environmental activities at your site. If residual contamination is encountered in the future, appropriate measures must be implemented to assure that it is managed following all applicable regulations. If future site conditions indicate that any remaining contamination poses a threat, and subsequent information indicates a need to reopen this case, any original claim under the PECFA fund would also reopen and you may apply for assistance to the extent of remaining eligibility.

This letter serves as your written notice of "no further action". PECFA claimants seeking reimbursement of interest costs are encouraged to submit, if applicable, a final reimbursement claim within 120 days after they receive written notification that no further action is required with respect to the discharge at their site. If your claim is not received within 120 days of the date of this letter, interest costs incurred after 60 days of the date of this letter will not be eligible for PECFA reimbursement. Costs associated with recording deed notices or other restrictions are not eligible for PECFA reimbursement.






