Dear Mr. Albrecht:

I have received the filed groundwater use restriction for Milwaukee Gear #3 site from Sigma Environmental on this date as required in my letter dated June 5, 2001. Based on the investigation and remedial documentation provided to the Department, it appears that the above-named site is in compliance with the requirements of Chs. NR 700 to 726, Wis. Admin. Code, as applicable. Therefore, the Department considers the case closed and tracked as such, having determined that no further action is necessary at the site at this time. However, the case may be reopened pursuant to S. NR 726.09, Wis. Admin. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, welfare, or the environment.

Groundwater Monitoring Wells


The Department has determined that because of machine lube oil contamination that has not been fully investigated for this site (Milwaukee Gear #4 site), all wells that define the contamination plume are not to be abandoned at this time. This includes "clean" wells outside the plume boundary necessary to define the groundwater plume. Monitoring of contaminants will be required soon, if not all of these wells to further define the contamination plume. Groundwater monitoring wells not relevant to the machine oil lube contamination must be abandoned per chapter NR 726.05 (8) of the Wisconsin Administration Code. This information was received at this office within 60 days.

Dear Mr. Jagdfeld:

This letter is in response to the case closure request submitted by Fox Environmental for the above-named site dated March 14, 2001. This letter only addresses the VOC contamination investigated and monitored on this site. This case was presented to the Department's closure committee on June 6, 2001. Based on the investigation and remedial documentation provided to the Department, the Department considers the case "conditionally closed" and tracked as such, having determined that no further action is necessary at this time. However, the case may be reopened pursuant to S. NR 726.09, Wis. Admin. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, welfare, or the environment. In order for this case to be officially closed and tracked as such on the Department's tracking system, the following must be completed:

1. Because of ch. NR 140 exceedances in MW-1 (vinyl chloride), MW-2 (cis-1,2-dichloroethene and tetrachloroethene), and MW-5 (trichloroethene), the Department requires a groundwater use restriction for the property at the county register of deeds office which will satisfy the requirements in s. NR 726.05(2)(b) and s. NR 726.05(8) Wis. Admin. Code. A draft copy of the groundwater use restriction must be sent to this office for review, before forwarding to WDNR legal staff in Madison for final approval. A copy of the final certified groundwater use restriction forwarded to this office at the time of recording.
2. Due to the lack of VOC soil sampling and analysis, the Department cannot assume that soils have attenuated to the point that they are no longer a direct contact issue. Therefore, the groundwater use restriction shall incorporate a statement addressing VOC soil contamination for this area. As an example, consider the following paragraph:

"WHEREAS, VOC discharges have occurred on this property in the area of MW-2 (see Figure 4, enclosed), the excavated area associated with the former gasoline underground storage tank. If construction is proposed, or the area is exposed to future development or improvement because of the current structural impediments, the property owner shall conduct an investigation of the degree and extent of VOC contamination. To the extent that contamination is found at

that time, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources shall be immediately notified and the contamination shall be properly remediated in accordance with applicable statutes and rules. If the currently inaccessible contaminated soil that remains on the property is excavated in the future, it will have to be sampled and analyzed and the treatment or disposal of the soil as a solid or hazardous waste may be necessary."

Groundwater Monitoring Wells

The Department has determined that because of machine lube oil contamination that has not been fully investigated for this site, all wells that define the contamination plume are not to be abandoned at this time. This includes "clean" wells outside the plume boundary necessary to define the groundwater plume. Monitoring of contaminants will require some, if not all of these wells to further define the contamination plume. Groundwater monitoring wells not relevant to the machine oil lube contamination and Milwaukee Gear #1 activity must be abandoned per chapter NR 726.05 (8)(c) Wisconsin Administration Code requirements, regarding monitoring well abandonment documentation, is received at this office within 60 days.

Machine Lube Oil Contamination

The Department agrees with Fox's request that a separate RP file for the machine lube oil contamination be issued. The enclosed RP letter addresses this case as:

Declaration of Restrictions

WHEREAS, THE MILWAUKEE GEAR COMPANY, a Wisconsin Corporation, formerly known as PORT AFFILIATES, INC., is the owner of the above-described property.

WHEREAS, VOC discharges have occurred on this property. Vinyl chloride and/or tetrachloroethene contaminated groundwater, above ch. NR 140, Wis. Adm. Code, enforcement standards, and/or cis-1,2-dichloroethene and/or trichloroethene contaminated groundwater, above ch. NR 140, Wis. Adm. Code, preventative action limits existed on this property at the location seen on the attached FIGURE A. The analytical groundwater data from the most recent sampling event performed at each of the property's monitoring wells is summarized on the attached TABLE 1. FIGURE A and TABLE 1 are hereby made a part of this restriction.

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the property owner to impose on the property restrictions which will make it unnecessary to conduct further groundwater remediation activities on the property at the present time.

WHEREAS, natural attenuation has been approved by the Department of Natural Resources to remediate groundwater contamination exceeding ch. NR 140, Wis. Adm. Code, groundwater standards within the boundaries of this property.

WHEREAS, construction of wells where the water quality does not comply with drinking water standards in ch. NR 809 is restricted by chs. NR 811 and NR 812, Wis. Adm. Code. Special well construction standards or water treatment requirements, or both, or well construction prohibitions may apply.

WHEREAS, VOC discharges have occurred on this property in the area of MW-2 (see Figure A, attached), the excavated area associated with a former gasoline underground storage tank. If construction is proposed, or the area is exposed to future development or improvement because of the current structural impediments, the property owner shall conduct an investigation of the degree and extent of VOC contamination. To the extent that contamination is found at that time, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources shall be immediately notified and the contamination shall be properly remediated in accordance with applicable statutes and rules. If the currently inaccessible contaminated soil that remains on the property is excavated in the future, it will have to be sampled and analyzed and the treatment or disposal of the soil as a solid or hazardous waste may be necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, the owner hereby declares that all of the property described above is held and shall be held, conveyed or encumbered, leased, rented, used, occupied and improved subject to the following limitation and restrictions:

Anyone who proposes to construct or reconstruct a well on this property is required to contact the Department of Natural Resources' Bureau of Drinking Water and Groundwater, or its successor agency, to determine what specific requirements are applicable, prior to constructing or reconstructing a well on this property. No well may be constructed on this property unless applicable requirements are met.

If construction is proposed on this property that will require dewatering, or if groundwater is to be otherwise extracted from this property, while this groundwater use restriction is in effect, the groundwater shall be sampled and analyzed for contaminants that were previously detected on the property and any extracted groundwater shall be managed in compliance with applicable statutes and rules.

This restriction is hereby declared to be a covenant running with the land and shall be fully binding upon all persons acquiring the above-described property whether by descent, devise, purchase or otherwise. This restriction benefits and is enforceable by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, its successors or assigns. The Department, its successors or assigns, may initiate proceedings at law or in equity against any person or persons who violate or are proposing to violate this covenant, to prevent the proposed violation or to recover damages for such violation.

Any person who is or becomes owner of the property described above may request that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or its successor issue a determination that one or more of the restrictions set forth in this covenant is no longer required. Upon the receipt of such a request, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources shall determine whether or not the restrictions contained herein can be extinguished. If the Department determines that the restrictions can be extinguished, an affidavit, attached to a copy of the Department's written determination, may be recorded to give notice that this deed restriction, or portions of this deed restriction, are no longer binding.




Figure 1: Site Map


